

Borehamwood Cattle Byre

The cattle were taken to the byre to be **milked**.

First the cow was place in the **stalls**. Then the milkmaid sat on a **milking** stool. The milk was put into **pails** and then carried using a yoke to a churn.

After the cow was milked the milk was used to make cream, **butter** and cheese.

Butter was made in a butter churn.
