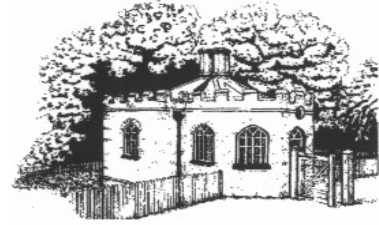


High Wycombe Toll House
