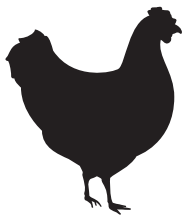
Animals need some things to live and survive.

These are called Habitats.



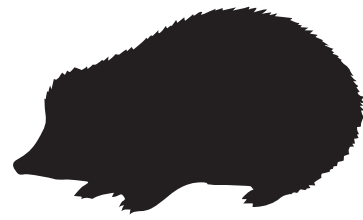
